eLab System Requirements	
Web Browser	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Internet Explorer 8-9 or higher (HTML5 content displayed using Flash for IE8) • Edge 40 • Firefox 20-24 (HTML5 content displayed using Flash for Firefox 20-23) • Chrome 25.0 or higher
PDF File Viewer	A PDF file viewer such as Adobe Acrobat Reader or Pro is needed to open overview presentations, which are saved in PDF for optimal viewing on any web browser.
Adobe Flash Player	Flash is needed to view simulation, hotspot, sequence, and matching questions, as well as video tutorials created for <i>Office 2013 and earlier</i> content. <i>Multimedia content associated with Office 2016 content was created in HTML5 and Flash is NOT required.</i>
Screen Resolution	The minimum resolution is 1280 x 768 and a resolution of 1440 x 990 is recommended.
